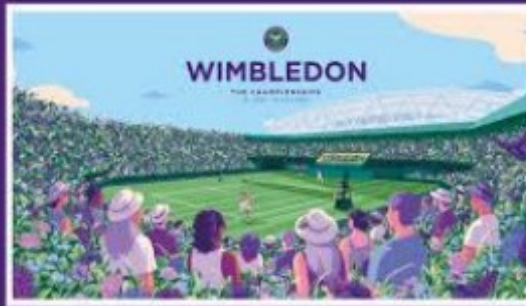


# Reception's Trip to Cassiobury Park

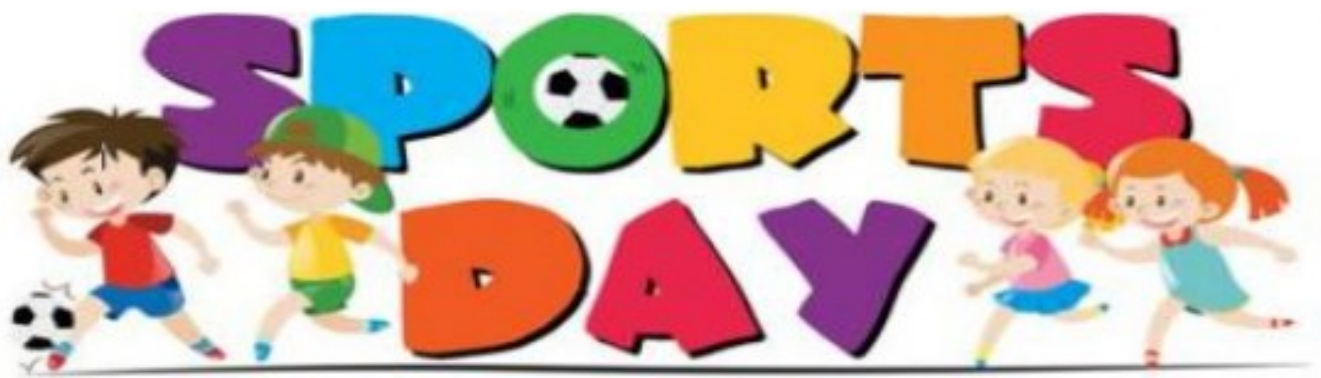
